



PERTH EAST 2018 Municipal Election

NEW THIS YEAR – VOTE ONLINE OR FROM YOUR PHONE!

VOTING METHOD:

Voting in the 2018 municipal election will be completed using the **Internet or Telephone**. These methods allow voters to vote securely anytime during the voting period from anywhere with internet or telephone access, including the comfort of your own home. The security, integrity and accuracy of the 2018 Election process is critical and every precaution has been taken to ensure this.

VOTING PERIOD:

Voting via internet and telephone will begin Friday, October 12 at 10:00 a.m. and end Monday, October 22 at 8:00 p.m. You can cast a vote 24 hours a day during the voting period.

Voters are encouraged to **vote early** – should they require any assistance.

TO VOTE YOU MUST:

- 1) Be qualified as an elector and eligible to vote if on Voting Day you are:
 - A resident, owner or tenant, or spouse of an owner or tenant of land in the Township of Perth East;
 - A Canadian citizen;
 - At least 18 years old on Voting Day; and
 - Not otherwise prohibited from voting.
- 2) Be registered on the Voter's List. Visit the Township's website at www.pertheast.ca/voterlookup2018 to check directly online if you are a registered voter. If you aren't on the list, follow the steps on the website OR you can visit the Municipal Office and be registered to vote in person (please bring proof of residency or ownership of property).
- 3) Receive a Voter Information Letter (which will be mailed out to you early in October if you are on the Voter's List). **If you have not received your Voter Information Letter by October 11**, please contact the Clerk's Office at 519-595-2800.

WHAT IS CONTAINED IN THE VOTER INFORMATION LETTER:



The Voter Information Letter contains your Personalized Identification Number (PIN) which you will need, along with your date of birth, to log onto the voting system and complete voting. To vote, electors will need to access the designated internet address or telephone number provided to cast their votes.

The letter will contain instructions for voting and the candidates will be listed on the ballot for each office. If you are not on the Voter's List, you will need to be added and a Voter Information Letter will be issued to you.

Voting closes on October 22, 2018 at 8:00 p.m.
