Province Wide Emergency Brake - Township of Perth East Services

April 1, 2021, Perth East—The Township of Perth East's first priority is to ensure the health and safety of residents, visitors and staff.

Effective April 3, 2021 at 12:01 am the Township of Perth East will enter Emergency Brake measures under the Province of Ontario COVID-19 Response Framework: Keeping Ontario Safe and Open. As a result of the Provincial Emergency Brake the following measures will be instituted:

- Perth East Recreational facilities and halls are closed to the public. Staff members will be at the office and available to answer questions via telephone or email.
- The Perth East Public Library will be providing curbside service only. All programming is cancelled. Staff members will be available to answer questions via telephone or email.
- The Municipal Office will continue to be open. Applications can be accepted through the mail, via email, and some through our online services. Staff members will be at the office and available to answer questions via telephone or email. **We encourage residents to use contactless methods wherever possible.**
- The Building Department office will continue to be open. Staff members are available by telephone (519-595-2800 ext. 241) and email to answer any questions.
- A mail drop-box is available 24-7 at the entrance to the Council Chambers.
- Water, wastewater, landfill, public works and emergency response services are proceeding as usual.
