Proof of vaccination will be required for everyone 12+ attending Recreation Facilities in Perth East

October 13, 2021 Perth East—The Township of Perth East's first priority is to ensure the health and safety of residents, visitors and staff.

Huron Perth Public Health, the Middlesex-London Health Unit and Southwestern Public Health announced additional proof of vaccination requirements on October 6, 2021 for recreational facilities used for organized sports.

Huron Perth Public Health has issued a [letter of instruction](#) outlining that proof of COVID-19 vaccination will now be required for anyone over the age of 12 who enters an indoor area of a sport or recreational fitness facility to participate in, coach, officiate, or watch organized sport. The requirement will come into effect on October 31st.

This includes each person, age 12 or older who attends the recreation facility for the purpose of:

- Actively participating in an organized sport
- Coaching, officiating organized sport or volunteering
- Spectating at organized sports

The following will be exempt from these requirements:

- Individuals who cannot receive the vaccine due to medical exemptions. A valid note from a Registered Physician or Nurse Practitioner must be shown upon entry.
- Emergency responders; police, firefighters or paramedics at the time that they are responding to an emergency

To obtain a vaccination receipt, individuals can download or print their vaccine report from the provincial booking portal at covid19.ontariohealth.ca or by calling the Provincial Vaccine Booking Line at 1-833-943-3900. Individuals requiring assistance to print their vaccine report can contact the Perth East Public Library at 519-595-8396 or attend the branch of the Perth East Public Library in person.
