Ontario moves into Step Three of its Roadmap to Reopen

July 20, 2021 Perth East—The Township of Perth East's first priority is to ensure the health and safety of residents, visitors and staff.

Ontario has moved into Step Three of its Roadmap to Reopen. Step 3 includes further expanding access to indoor settings, with restrictions, including where there are larger numbers of people and where face coverings can't always be worn. The following Township of Perth East services have reopened with restrictions in place:

- The Municipal Office is open to in-person transactions. We can accept applications through the mail, via email and some through our online services. Staff members will be at the office and are available to answer questions via telephone or email.
- The Perth East Public Library is open to the public. Patrons are required to wear a mask while in the building.
- All Sport fields such as baseball diamonds, soccer fields and picnic sites are re-opened with restrictions in place.
- Morningdale Park and the PERC Auditorium are available for booking following gathering restrictions. Please contact the Perth East Recreation Complex at 519-595-8375.
- The PERC Pool is open. All programs (public swim, aquafit and lane swim) require pre-registration and COVID screening. All program and registration information can be found at pertheast.ca/recreationprograms.
- The Building Department office is open to the public. Staff members are available by telephone (519-595-2800 ext. 241) and email to answer any questions.
- Appointments for the Municipal Office are still recommended – Call 519-595-2800 to book.
- A mail drop-box is available 24-7 at the entrance to the Council Chambers.
- Larger items may be dropped off at the front lobby of the Municipal Building during office hours 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Water, wastewater, landfill, public works and emergency response services are proceeding as usual.
- Council, Board and Committee meetings will proceed virtually as scheduled.
